7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$27,000.00 IN GRANT
8 FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE
9 CONSERVATION COMMISSION (THE "FWC") FOR
10 REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S
11 COSTS TO REMOVE THREE DERELICT VESSELS IN CITY
12 OF JACKSONVILLE WATERWAYS, AS INITIATED BY
13 REVISED B.T. 21-096; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
14 THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL
15 QUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
21 listed in subsection (b):

24 incorporated herein by this reference)

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$27,000.00

1 in grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife
2 Conservation Commission (the "FWC") for reimbursement to
3 the City of the costs to remove three derelict vessels
4 located in City waterways.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to appropriate \$27,000.00 in grant funding from the FWC
7 to the City to cover the City's costs for removal of three (3)
8 derelict vessels located in the public waterways within the
9 jurisdiction of the City. Pursuant to that certain Florida Fish and
10 Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement No. 20367 between FWC and
11 the City ("Contract #20367"), the FWC will reimburse the City up to
12 \$17,000.00 for removal of a 34 foot home-built sailboat and a 21 foot
13 Arrowgls speedboat, both of which are located in the Trout River. A
14 copy of Contract #20367 is **On File** with the Office of Legislative
15 Services.

16 In addition, pursuant to the terms and conditions of that
17 certain Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement
18 No. 20377 between the FWC and the City ("Contract #20377"), the FWC
19 will reimburse the City up to \$10,000.00 for removal of a 27 foot
20 Hunter Marine Sailboat located in the intracoastal waterway north of
21 the Beach Boulevard bridge. A copy of Contract #20377 is **On File**
22 with the Office of Legislative Services.

23 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Environmental Quality
24 Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall provide oversight of
25 the project described herein.

26 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
28 without the Mayor's signature.
