Type of Action: Appropriation, CIP amendment and designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$171,364 supplemental grant funds from the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for reimbursement of the City's costs related to construction and construction oversight of installation of pedestrian safety improvements on Park Street and Margaret Street from Riverside Avenue to the Interstate-95 ramps. The 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan is amended to reflect the appropriation for this project. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Public Works Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for pedestrian safety improvements in Riverside, including the addition of raised crosswalks, the upgrade of existing crosswalks, and re-timing signal controls. This funding supplements the \$231,758 in funding previously appropriated by Ordinance 2023-763-E.
