Section 3. Updated Precinct Boundary Map of Entire County in the Files at Supervisor of Elections and Council Secretary Offices. An updated precinct boundary map of the entire county, a map of each new precinct, and the locations of all polling place locations are in the files of the Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary in their respective offices. A written description of each precinct boundary is in the Supervisor of Elections' files in his office.
