8 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING VOTING PRECINCTS;  
9 APPROVING THE REVISION AND CHANGES OF CERTAIN  
10 VOTING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES IN THE CITY OF  
11 JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS  
12 REQUESTED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS  
13 PURSUANT TO SECTION 352.101, *ORDINANCE CODE*;  
14 APPROVING THE REVISION AND CHANGES OF CERTAIN  
15 VOTING POLLING LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF  
16 JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS  
17 REQUESTED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS  
18 PURSUANT TO SECTION 352.102, *ORDINANCE CODE*; ALL  
19 TO BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY; PROVIDING FOR  
20 PRECINCT MAPS ON FILE AND ONLINE; PROVIDING FOR  
21 POLLING LOCATIONS ON FILE AND ONLINE; REQUESTING  
22 ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN  
23 EFFECTIVE DATE.

25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Certain Precinct Boundary Changes Approved;**  
27 **Authorizing and Directing Supervisor of Elections and Council**  
28 **Secretary to Include Precinct Boundary Changes in the Files in Their**  
29 **Respective Offices.** At the request of the Supervisor of Elections  
30 for Duval County, and pursuant to Section 352.101, *Ordinance Code*,  
31 the Council, acting as the governing body for Duval County, hereby

1 approves the precinct boundary changes of Precincts 1002, 1003, 1005,  
2 and 1107, which encompasses former 1103, in the City of Jacksonville,  
3 Duval County, Florida, as reflected in the City Council District 10  
4 and District 11 maps attached hereto as **Exhibit 1 (Precinct Boundary**  
5 **Changes)**. The Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary are  
6 hereby authorized and directed to include the Precinct Boundary  
7 Changes on file in their respective offices.

8 **Section 2. Updated Polling Place Locations Approved;**  
9 **Authorizing and Directing Supervisor of Elections and Council**  
10 **Secretary to Include Polling Place Locations in the Files in Their**  
11 **Respective Offices Maps on File.** At the request of the Supervisor  
12 of Elections for Duval County, and pursuant to Section 352.102,  
13 *Ordinance Code*, the Council, acting as the governing body for Duval  
14 County, hereby approves the updated polling place locations in City  
15 Council Districts 10 and 11, as listed in the attached **Exhibit 2**  
16 **(Polling Place Locations)** to be effective immediately for all special,  
17 primary, and general elections conducted after passage. The  
18 Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary are hereby  
19 authorized and directed to include the updated Polling Place Locations  
20 on file in their respective offices.

21 **Section 3. Updated Precinct Boundary Map of Entire County**  
22 **in the Files at Supervisor of Elections and Council Secretary Offices.**  
23 An updated precinct boundary map of the entire county, a map of each  
24 new precinct, and the locations of all polling place locations are  
25 in the files of the Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary  
26 in their respective offices. A written description of each precinct  
27 boundary is in the Supervisor of Elections' files in his office.

31 **Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**

1 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this  
2 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the  
3 changes of the boundaries and precinct locations must be mapped and  
4 the impacted citizens must be notified prior to the upcoming March  
5 2024 elections.

6 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
7 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
8 without the Mayor's signature.
