5 A RESOLUTION CELEBRATING THE 8TH ANNUAL NATIONAL
6 APPRENTICESHIP WEEK WHICH WILL TAKE PLACE
7 NOVEMBER 14TH THROUGH 20TH; PROVIDING AN
8 EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 **WHEREAS**, National Apprenticeship Week is a nationwide
11 celebration where industry, labor, equity, workforce, education, and
12 government leaders host events to showcase the successes and value
13 of the Registered Apprenticeship program to re-building our economy,
14 advancing racial and gender equity, and supporting underserved
15 communities; and

16 **WHEREAS**, National Apprenticeship Week is an opportunity to
17 highlight how Registered Apprenticeship, a proven and industry-driven
18 training model, provides a critical talent pipeline that can help to
19 address some of our nation's pressing workforce challenges such as
20 rebuilding our country's infrastructure, addressing critical supply
21 chain demands, supporting a clean energy workforce, modernizing our
22 cybersecurity response, and responding to core economic issues; and

23 **WHEREAS**, apprenticeships create a strong career pathway that
24 provides employees the opportunity to earn a salary while learning
25 the skills necessary to succeed in high-demand careers and
26 apprenticeships that support employers to cultivate high-quality
27 talent pools that grow their businesses and address their workforce
28 needs; and

29 **WHEREAS**, National Apprenticeship Week is an opportunity to
30 recognize the positive impact apprenticeships have on youth, adults,
31 businesses, and the Jacksonville economy; now therefore

1 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2 **Section 1.** The City of Jacksonville hereby recognizes
3 "National Apprenticeship Week," and encourages all Jacksonville
4 apprenticeship program sponsors to sponsor and participate in events
5 in your community during the week of November 14 - 20, 2022 to
6 recognize and celebrate the many benefits and contributions by
7 registered apprentices and other entities that are directly involved
8 in the City of Jacksonville.
