The proposed legislation is a recommendation of the Industrial Development Revenue Bond (IRB)

Review Committee, that the Mayor submit legislation to approve, for purposes of Section 147(f) of the

Internal Revenue Code, the issuance of Health Care Facilities Bonds by Genesis Health Inc. (dba - Brooks

Rehabilitative Services) in one or more installments or series, in an aggregate principal amount not to

exceed \$200,000,000. The bond issuance will be for the purpose of providing funds to be loaned by the

Issuer for the purpose of:

- (a) Financing the construction and equipping of a 60 bed Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility;
- (b) Refunding the outstanding Private Issue Debt Series 2013, 2011 and 2010 bonds;
- (c) Financing or reimbursing the swap termination payment relating to an interest rate swap entered into by a Brooks affiliate with Compass Bank (now BBVA USA) on or about August 16,2010 in contemplation of refunding the 2010 Private Issue Debt described above;
- (d) Financing or reimbursing the swap termination payment relating to an interest rate swap entered into by a Brooks affiliate with Compass Bank (now BBVA USA) on or about May 31, 2011 in contemplation of refunding the 2011 Private Issue Debt described above;
- (e) Reimbursing capital expenditures;
- (f) Funding a portion of interest accruing on the Bonds for a period not in excess of 18 months;
- (g) Funding a debt service reserve for the Bonds, if required; and
- (h) Paying all or a portion of the costs of issuing the Bonds.
