- (3) On page 7, line 16, strike "Revised On File" and insert "Fourth Revised On File";
- (4) On page 8, line 4, strike "Revised Exhibit 1" and insert "Fourth Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Fourth Revised Exhibit 1, 4th Rev B.T. 24-023, December 5, 2023 Finance"";
- (5) On page 8, lines 7 and 9, strike "attached";
- (6) Remove Revised Exhibit 1 and replace with Fourth Revised Exhibit 1, attached hereto, which attaches the fourth revised B.T. 24-023 to reflect that \$100,000 for the Small Business Capital Access program will be for micro-grants and low-interest loans for JSEBs;
- (7) Remove Revised On File and replace with Fourth Revised On File, attached hereto, which attaches the fourth revised Mayor's Task Force Programs and Initiatives Summary to reflect that a minimum of ten percent (\$100,000) of the funding for the Small Business Capital Access program will be allocated for microgrants and low-interest loans for JSEBs;
- (8) On page 1, line 1, amend the introductory sentence to add that
