Type of Action: Appointment confirmation and *Ordinance Code* waiver

Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Palecia Crawford-Maddox to the KingSoutel Crossing Community Redevelopment Agency Advisory Board, replacing Leola Williams, representing the general public as a citizen who lives within one mile of the CRA boundary. Section 53.202(a)(4), *Ordinance Code* is waived because the appointee does not live within one mile of the CRA boundary.

Background Information: Chapter 53, Part 2, *Ordinance Code*, establishes the KingSoutel Crossing Community Redevelopment Agency Advisory Board serve in an advisory capacity to the KingSoutel Crossing Community Redevelopment Agency.

Sec. 53.202, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Advisory Board shall consist of seven members, to include four members appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation of the Council, who are citizens representing the general public that live within one mile of the CRA boundary.

Ms. Crawford-Maddox holds a bachelor's degree from Edward Waters University. She works for Checkpoint Clearing, and she manages the Young Legends Childcare Center which is located within the KingSoutel Crossing CRA. Ms. Crawford-Maddox resides in Duval County in council district 8.
