6 A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING ROSEMARY
7 WESOLOWSKI UPON HER RETIREMENT AFTER TWENTY
8 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE CITY OF
9 JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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11 **WHEREAS**, Rosemary Wesolowski retired on July 11, 2025, after
12 faithfully serving the City of Jacksonville for twenty years,
13 beginning her tenure on April 11, 2005, as a Human Services Planner
14 II, advancing to Human Services Planner III, and culminating in her
15 role as Senior Neighborhoods Services Coordinator within the
16 Neighborhoods Department; and

17 **WHEREAS**, during her distinguished career, Ms. Wesolowski made
18 significant contributions to improving the quality of life in
19 Jacksonville's neighborhoods, providing guidance, resources, and
20 support to residents and the community; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Wesolowski played a key role in supporting the
22 Southeast Citizens Planning Advisory Committee (CPAC), where she
23 facilitated more than 500 meetings between 2005 and 2025, contributed
24 to the successful 2025 Neighborhoods, USA (NUSA) Conference in
25 Jacksonville, and provided annual CommUniverCity training to prepare
26 neighborhoods' leaders to advocate for their communities; and

27 **WHEREAS**, she also organized and participated in a wide range of
28 community initiatives, including association creation, clean-ups, and
29 back-to-school programs, and earned the Historic Preservation Project
30 Award from the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission for her
31 work, along with Old Arlington Inc., on the 60th Anniversary of the

1 Mathews Bridge Celebration, and supported and staffed the
2 Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission from 2011
3 to 2016; and

4 **WHEREAS**, she earned her Bachelor's degree from the University
5 of North Florida, reflecting her dedication to excellence and the
6 strong foundation she brought to her two decades of service with the
7 City of Jacksonville; and

8 **WHEREAS**, she has been recognized for her strong commitment to
9 public service, professionalism, and the positive relationships she
10 built with residents, colleagues, and community partners; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Wesolowski's dedication, institutional knowledge,
12 and tireless advocacy for Jacksonville's neighborhoods have left a
13 lasting impact that will benefit the community for years to come; now
14 therefore

15 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby honors and commends
17 Rosemary Wesolowski for her twenty years of dedicated service to the
18 City and extends its best wishes in her retirement.

19 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
21 without the Mayor's signature.
