PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain why this legislation is necessary. Provide, who, what, when where, how and the impact.) The existing Public Investment Policy (PIP) was originally approved by Ordinance 2016-382-E. The OED has only submitted two minor amendments (Ordinances 2018-370-E and 2019-243-E) since then. The DIA recently updated the PIP via Ordinance 2022-372-E with regard to the Downtown Program Incentives. OED is requesting this amendment to primarily cleanup some outstanding items; however, the Amendment does not affect the ROI measurement process.
The material changes are listed below:
1. State Programs have been deleted. Several of the programs have been eliminated by the State (such as QTI) and others have been modified. As such, we felt it more appropriate to have the City PIP only refer to programs the City offers.
2. The Local QTI Bonus Program has been eliminated as it was contingent upon the company being approved for a QTI incentive through the State, which is no longer a potential option.
3. One local program, "Local Targeted Industry Employment Grant", was added. This is designed to closely resemble the local participation portion in the former State QTI Program and is capped at \$5,000 per job. We have used this incentive in the past; however, it required a waiver as it has not been included in the PIP.
4. The criteria to qualify for a REV Grant have been modified. The wage requirement (greater than or equal to the State of Florida average wage) would not be a requirement for projects located in Economically Distressed Areas, CRA's or for projects causing a capital investment of not less than \$10,000,000.
