Section 3. Reverter. Any funds remaining shall be returned to the account of origin upon completion of the respective project for which it was appropriated.

Section 4. Providing a Condition on Expenditure of Funds for the Baldwin Park Fire Station Project. The funds appropriated herein for the Baldwin Park Fire Station project shall not be encumbered or expended until the City of Jacksonville has taken ownership of the fire station.

Section 5. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds for each project as more fully described herein and in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev CIP Sheets, July 22, 2025 - Floor", and incorporated herein by this reference.
