5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDING IN THE
6 AMOUNT OF \$350,000.00 FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA,
7 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TO THE MONUMENT
8 AND REGENCY TRAFFIC SIGNAL REBUILD - OTHER
9 CONSTRUCTION COSTS ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE FUNDING
10 FOR DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION AND
11 CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION AND
12 RELATED ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDING NEW FIBER
13 OPTIC INTERCONNECT FROM ATRIUM WAY/REGENCY
14 SQUARE BOULEVARD NORTH TO LEE ROAD TO PROVIDE
15 NETWORK ACCESS (THE "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY
16 B.T. 26-067; AMENDING THE 2026-2030 FIVE-YEAR
17 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
18 2025-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF
19 FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
20 THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT
21 DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;
22 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2025-2026 fiscal year,
26 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
27 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
28 listed in subsection (b):

4 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

5 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
6 funds from the State of Florida, Department of
7 Transportation ("FDOT"), in the amount of \$350,000.00 to
8 the Monument and Regency Traffic Signal Rebuild - Other
9 Construction Costs account to provide funds for the for
10 the Monument and Regency Traffic Signal Rebuild project
11 (the "Project") as described herein. No City match is
12 required.

13 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
14 Section 1 is to make grant funds from FDOT available for the Project.
15 The Project will include design, construction, and construction,
16 engineering and inspection services for traffic signalization and
17 related roadway improvements including a new fiber optic interconnect
18 from Atrium Way/Regency Square Boulevard North to Lee Road to provide
19 network access to Tredinick Parkway, the I-295 southbound ramp, the
20 I-295 northbound ramp, and Lee Road. Funding from FDOT for the Project
21 is subject to the terms and conditions outlined in the State Funded
22 Grant Agreement (Contract No. G3M76) a copy of which is **On File** with
23 the City Council Legislative Services Division (the "Agreement"). The
24 Agreement requires the Project be completed on or before June 30,
25 2029.

26 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
27 2025-505-E, adopting the 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
28 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
29 hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project,
30 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached
31 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The

1 City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP
2 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to
3 the best interests of the community because it could result in a
4 delay in the receipt of the grant funds and delay Project
5 construction.

6 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
7 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
8 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
9 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
10 an amendment to Ordinance 2025-505-E. In all other respects, the
11 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2025-505-E
12 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

13 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Engineering and Construction
14 Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee
15 the Project and Agreement described herein.

16 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
18 without the Mayor's signature.
