**Type of Action:** Approve temporary and permanent changes in polling place locations, and boundary changes within various precincts

**Bill Summary:** This ordinance approves temporary and permanent changes in polling place locations, and boundary changes within various precincts, to be effective for the 2026 Primary Election to be held August 18, 2026, in the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, as requested by the Supervisor of Elections pursuant to Section 352.102, *Ordinance Code*.

**Background Information:** At the request of the Supervisor of Elections of Duval County, and pursuant to Section 352.102, *Ordinance Code*, the Council, acting as a the governing body for Duval County approves a temporary change in polling place location for Precincts 208 and 604, and a permanent change in polling place location for Precincts 105, 211, 307, 508, 811, 1104, 1105, and 1405. It also approves boundary changes for the following Precincts: 1104, 1401, 1406, and 1408.

**Policy Impact Area:** Supervisor of Elections, polling place location change, precinct boundary change

**Fiscal Impact:** No cost to the City.
