RESOLUTION 2026-113

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S 2026 LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS RELATED TO TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING A RECOMMENDATION TO THE NORTH FLORIDA TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (the "TPO") is the independent regional transportation planning agency for Duval, Clay, Nassau and St. Johns counties and was established pursuant to Section 339.175, *Florida Statutes*, to lead the region's efforts in planning, funding and mobilizing resources to develop and maintain our transportation system; and

WHEREAS, the TPO has requested recommendations from its constituent public agencies on prioritization of projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville makes recommendations by adoption of a Resolution by the City Council, and desires to provide its recommendations to the TPO; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby recommends to the TPO its "2026 List of Priority Projects" attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, dated January 29, 2026.

Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage for this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the City Council would like to ensure this Resolution is timely acted

1 upon so that it can be forwarded to the TPO for consideration prior
2 to final approval of their projects.

3 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
5 without the Mayor's signature.
