24-230	Amendment	(ORD-Q Rezoning at 0 Francis Rd & 0 W Edgewood Ave, btwn Cleveland Rd & Edgewood Ave W from CRO & CCG-1 to PUD, to Permit Up to 88 Townhomes, as Described in the Francis Pointe PUD): 1. Attaches a Revised Exhibit 3 (Revised PUD Written Description dated May 15, 2024). 2. Attaches a Revised Exhibit 4 (Revised PUD Site Plan dated May 16, 2024).
		2. Attaches a Revised Exhibit 4 (Revised FOD Site Fian dated May 10, 2024).
24-286	Amendment	(ORD Apv & Auth the Public Investment Policy of the OED to Add the Following Small Business Capital Access Progs (1) Small Business Micro-grant Funding Initiative, (2) Small Business Low-interest Loan Funding, (3) Veterans Entrepreneurship Funding, & (4) JSEB Funding, & the Following Jax Film & Television Progs (1) Jax Qualified Film & TV Production Incentive Prog, (2) Jax Fostering Filmmakers Grant Prog, & (3) Jax Commercial Production Prog): 1. Include Ord. 2024-165-E within listing of previous amendments to the Public Investment Policy. 2. Clarify within the bill that the Business Infrastructure Grant/Loan (BIG) program and Small Business Development Initiative (SBDI) program criteria are also being revised. 3. Include public purpose language for the additional programs being added to the Public Investment Policy. 4. Place revised Public Investment Policy on file to make the following changes: a. Revise the criteria for the Small Business Low-Interest Loan Program to include the tier structure and amounts established in Ord. 2023-807-E. b. Clarify within the Veterans Entrepreneurship Funding that recipients must attend and complete a mandatory small business education course. c. Require grants to be provided on a reimbursement basis (Small Business Micro-Grant Funding Initiative, Veterans Entrepreneurship Funding, and Jacksonville Small & Emerging Business Funding – grant only). d. Add definition of High Impact Television Series within the Jacksonville Qualified Film & TV Production Incentive Program (6-24 episodes that are 30-60 minutes each, with a minimum cost of \$400,000 per episode). e. Require business and residence to be located in Duval County for the four new small business capital access programs. f. Define business net worth and employee caps for each of the tier classifications within the small business capital access programs. g. Revise criteria for Jacksonville Small & Emerging Business Funding to clarify eligibility and levels of assistance.
