Type of Action: Approve and authorize the Mayor to deliver an amendment to an agreement; designate oversight agency

Bill Summary: This bill approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute and deliver an amendment to the FY 24-25 Grant Agreement between the City and the Boselli Foundation, Inc., for the Teach Fellowship and Mentoring Programs as originally authorized by Ordinance 2024-839-E, subject to a revised term sheet and budget. The bill also designates the Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department as the oversight agency.

Background Information: The Teacher Fellowship is a year-long program that provides qualified K-12 teachers professional learning and skills development opportunities. The Mentoring Program fosters leadership development for young men by promoting self-worth, communication skills and the ability to lead oneself and others through increased self-awareness. City funds were originally appropriated to support various administrative costs for Boselli to operate the programs. The revised term sheet and budget reflect a reallocation of funds from certain salaries and benefits for positions, as well as funds allocated for certain occupancy expenses and direct client expenses. It redirects those funds to pay the costs for dental and other benefits for positions supporting the programs and other occupancy expenses, including insurance, postage, professional fees and services, and supplies.
