**Bill Summary:** The bill appropriates \$600,000 from the Mobility Plan Project – Zone 4 account to fund the design of a traffic signalization and intersection improvement project at the intersection of Braddock Road and Dunn Avenue on the Northside and authorizes the execution of an agreement between the City and the Florida Department of Transportation for design of the project by the FDOT. It amends the 2025-29 Capital Improvement Plan to reflect the appropriation of funds to this project and designates the Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Public Works Department as the oversight agency for the project.

**Background Information:** Dunn Avenue is a state highway (SR 104) and Braddock Road is a local road. The funding will provide for design of a project that will include installation of traffic signals and the addition of turn lanes at the intersection. The funding will come from Mobility Zone 4 available funds.
