Type of Action: Appropriation, CIP amendment, and designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$350,000 in grant funds from the State of Florida, Department of Transportation. The 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan is amended to reflect funding for the project. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the Monument and Regency Traffic Signal Rebuild project. The project includes design, construction, and construction, engineering and inspection services for traffic signalization and related roadway improvements including a new fiber optic interconnect from Atrium Way/Regency Square Boulevard North to Lee Road to provide network access to Tredinick Parkway, the I-295 southbound ramp, the I-295 northbound ramp, and Lee Road. The Project will be completed on or before June 30, 2029.
