BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby recognizes the week of October 21st through October 27th, 2024, as Florida City Government Week and encourages all residents and City officials and employees to participate in events and activities that recognize and celebrate Florida City Government Week. The Council further encourages educational partnerships between City government, schools, civic groups and other organizations in furtherance of the ideals behind Florida City Government Week and the shared mission of these entities to better the lives of their respective residents and visitors alike.
