
The US Department of Justice has approved the City of Jacksonville/Jacksonville Sheriff's Office's (COJ/JSO) application for financial assistance submitted under the Kevin and Avonte Program: Reducing Injury and Death of Missing Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities, in the amount of \$134,615.00. These funds will be used to expand an existing tracking program from 20 to 220 devices, and will cover expenses for the purchase of the locative tracking devices and related supplies.

This legislation is necessary to appropriate the grant award from the US Department of Justice with no local match for the grant period of October 1st, 2023 to September 30th, 2026.
