ORDINANCE 2023-861-E

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; TO RE-NAME A PORTION OF "CHURCH STREET WEST" EXTENDING FROM JEFFERSON STREET NORTH TO A DEAD END BEHIND LAVILLA SCHOOL OF THE ARTS AS "RAY PLACE" IN COUNCIL DISTRICT CHARLES 7; RECOGNIZING THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF RAY CHARLES; WAIVER OF SECTION 745.105(H), ORDINANCE CODE, WHICH REQUIRES THAT ALL STREET NAME CHANGES BE FOR THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE STREET; WAIVER OF SECTION 745.105(I)(3), ORDINANCE CODE, WHICH REOUIRES THAT A PERSON RESIDE IN THE COMMUNITY WITHIN 5 MILES OF THE STREET NAME CHANGE FOR AT LEAST 10 YEARS; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR PROCESSING, IMPLEMENTATION, AND COORDINATION THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION, 911 EMERGENCY, FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, THE POST OFFICE AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville City Council seeks to re-name a portion of "Church Street West" to "Ray Charles Place" in honor of

the late musician, Ray Charles, who died in 2004; and

WHEREAS, according to his autobiography, "Brother Ray: Ray Charles' Own Story" well known musician, Ray Charles, lived in Jacksonville, during his teenage years, in the 1940's near downtown at 752 West Church Street with the Thompsons (Fred and Lena Mae); and

WHEREAS, Ray Charles' momentous connections to Jacksonville involved Fred Thompson taking Ray to the musician's union where he developed remarkable musical skills in lyrics and instruments especially the piano; and

WHEREAS, Ray Charles performed for bands at the Ritz Theatre in LaVilla establishing a solid reputation for his musical talents; and

WHEREAS, Ray Charles' countless musical contributions included signature hits such as "Georgia on My Mind," "Hit the Road Jack" and "I Can't Stop Loving You" and so many more; and

WHEREAS, Ray Charles received numerous awards, recognitions and honors including several Grammy Awards, inductions into several music halls of fame and his legacy continues to impact today's music genres; and

WHEREAS, the street name change from a portion of "Church Street West" to "Ray Charles Place" affects the address assignment of one property owner; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 745.105(j)(10), Ordinance Code, the Planning and Development Department mailed written notifications on September 13, 2023, and on October 17, 2023, to the affected property owner requesting the affected property owner to indicate their written consent or objection to the proposed honorary street designation. A copy of the first and second written notifications are attached as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 745.105(j)(10), Ordinance Code, the affected property owner is deemed to have consented to the

proposed honorary designations due to their non-response to the written notifications; and

WHEREAS, on September 6, 2023, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee reviewed the street name request and voted to accept the Staff Recommendation to re-name a portion of "Church Street West" to "Ray Charles Place". A copy of the minutes of the September 6, 2023, public meeting of the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee is attached as Exhibit 3; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2023, the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission ("JHPC") voted to adopt the Staff Report with a recommendation for approval to re-name a portion of "Church Street West" to "Ray Charles Place". A copy of the JHPC agenda, Staff Report and the excerpt minutes of the September 27, 2023, public meeting of the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission are attached hereto as Exhibit 4; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it appropriate to change a portion
of "Church Street West" to "Ray Charles Place"; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. A portion of Church Street West re-named as "Ray Charles Place". A portion of Church Street West extending from Jefferson Street North to the dead end at the Lavilla School is hereby re-named as "Ray Charles Place" by which name such street and physical location shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of "Ray Charles Place" is attached hereto as Exhibit 5.

Section 2. Waiver of Section 745.105(h), Ordinance Code. Section 745.105(h), Ordinance Code, which requires that all street name changes be for the entire length of the street is waived because the proposed street name of "Ray Charles Place" is long overdue for the honoree.

Section 3. Waiver of Section 745.105(i)(3), Ordinance Code.

Section 745.105(i)(3), Ordinance Code, which requires the person have

resided in the community within five miles of the street name change for at least 10 years is waived because the proposed street name of "Ray Charles Place" is long overdue for the honoree.

Section 4. Directing Legislative Services to forward a copy to the Planning and Development Department. The Chief of Legislative Services is requested to send a copy of this legislation, once enacted, to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Unit, for processing, implementation, and coordination with 911 Emergency, Fire and Rescue Department, the Post Office, Public Works Department, Traffic Engineering Division and other affected agencies and organizations.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
