AN ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$7,999,766.05 IN AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN OF 2021 GRANT FUNDS FROM VARIOUS ACCOUNTS WITHIN THE OTHER FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GRANTS - AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND INCLUDING (1) \$1,026,971.05 FROM OTHER FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GRANTS -AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND - U.S. TREASURY ACCOUNT TO OTHER ACCOUNTS WITHIN THE FUND, AND (2) \$6,972,795.00 TO THE ROOF REPLACEMENT - PAC PROJECT, TO COMPLY WITH AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN TIMING REQUIREMENTS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 24-125; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the account listed in subsection (b):

> funding above represents a reappropriation \$7,999,766.05 from the Other Federal, State and Local Grants - American Rescue Plan Local Fiscal Recovery Fund ("Fund") consisting of (1) a transfer of \$1,026,971.05 to accounts within the Fund including JXSF COVID 19 Premium Pay Raises - Shift Differential Account (\$17,131.03), JXSF COVID 19 Premium Pay Raises - Out of Class Pay Account (\$2,340.02), and JXSF COVID 19 Premium Pay One Time Payments - Lump Sum Payment - Pensionable Account (\$1,007,500.00), and (2) an appropriation of \$6,972,795.00to the Roof Replacement - PAC project ("CIP Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer funds within the Fund to repurpose unused funds from, and to comply with the timing requirements of, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, and to fund the CIP Project to address one-time capital needs of City venues to address critical deferred maintenance needs.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Projects, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP

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Sheet, August 6, 2024 - Finance" and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral could result in the City losing valuable grant dollars.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Oversight. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the CIP Project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
