AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$51,000 FROM THE SOCIAL JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT SPECIAL COMMITTEE CONTINGENCY FOR AN EXPANSION TO THE JAXCARECONNECT PROGRAM; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND WE CARE JACKSONVILLE, INC. FOR THE JAXCARECONNECT PROGRAM; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, PROVIDING FOR DIRECT CONTRACT WITH WE CARE JACKSONVILLE, INC. SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional funding for We Care Jacksonville, Inc. as more fully described in Exhibit 2 attached hereto. The additional funding to We Care Jacksonville, Inc. for the JaxCareConnect Program for a full-time administrative/marketing coordinator (\$50,000) and back-end website technology tools (\$1,000).

Agreement approved and execution authorized. 3. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the First Amendment to the Service Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and We Care Jacksonville, Inc., in substantially the form as attached hereto as On File, and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of We Care as stated in the Agreement, and Jacksonville, Inc. modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General

Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of We Care Jacksonville, Inc., to provide services for the JaxCareConnect program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Oversight. The Mayor is requested to appoint the Office of Grants and Contract Compliance to oversee the project in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
