Type of Action: Appropriation, agreement authorization, CIP amendment, one cycle emergency passage, designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$3,000,000, funds under the FDOT Grant Agreement. The agreements between the City and FDOT, and the City and Shipyards Trustee Jacksonville, LLC are authorized. The 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program is amended to reflect the project. One cycle emergency passage is requested so the project may be completed during the NFL off-season. The Department of Public Works, Engineering and Construction Management Division will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funding for Bay Street Pedestrian Safety Improvements. Improvements will include certain traffic calming improvements along Bay Street in the vicinity of the Stadium, inclusive of roadway and intersection improvements, and pedestrian and streetscape enhancements, to improve pedestrian safety and enhance access to adjacent developments.
