5 A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING MARSHA JACKSON AS A
6 MEMBER OF THE JACKSONVILLE - DUVAL COUNTY
7 COUNCIL ON ELDER AFFAIRS, AS THE COUNCIL
8 DISTRICT 10 REPRESENTATIVE, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER
9 82, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A SECOND FULL TERM
10 EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
11 DATE.

13 **WHEREAS**, Marsha Jackson was appointed to the Jacksonville -
14 Duval County Council on Elder Affairs through 2022-269-A as a District
15 8 representative; and

16 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to 2022-800-E, 2023-281-E, and the
17 Settlement Agreement in case number 3:22-cv-493-MMH-LLL, the *Charter*
18 *of the City of Jacksonville* was amended to approve and enact the City
19 of Jacksonville Redistricting Plan establishing City Council
20 Districts with new boundaries; and

21 **WHEREAS**, with the new Council District boundaries, Marsha
22 Jackson now resides in Council District 10; now therefore

23 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Reappointment.** The Council hereby reappoints
25 Marsha Jackson, a Duval County resident, to the Jacksonville - Duval
26 County Council on Elder Affairs, as the representative for Council
27 District 10, pursuant to Chapter 82, *Ordinance Code*, for a second
28 full term expiring June 30, 2025.

29 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
31 without the Mayor's signature.
