AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO: (1) EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, (A) AN AGREEMENT WITH SHANDS JACKSONVILLE MEDICAL CENTER, INC., AND (B) LETTERS OF AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA THROUGH ITS AGENCY FOR HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION, BOTH CONCERNING PAYMENT AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE CITY'S INDIGENT HEALTH CARE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$56,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026, AND (2) TAKE SUCH FURTHER ACTION AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 Section 1. Authorization. The Mayor, or her designee, and 22 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to: (1) execute and 23 deliver: (a) an agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Shands 24 Jacksonville Medical Center, Inc. ("Shands"), in substantially the 25 same form as is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 26 by this reference, and (b) Letters of Agreement between the City of 27 Jacksonville and the State of Florida Agency for Health Care Administration ("AHCA") in substantially the same forms as are 28 29 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and **Exhibit 3**, respectively, and 30 incorporated herein by this reference (collectively, the "Agreements"), all of which concern payment and distribution of the 31

City's indigent health care funds in the amount of \$56,000,000 for 1 2 fiscal year 2025-2026, and (2) take such further action as may be 3 necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance, including executing any amendments to the Agreements as mutually 4 agreed to by the parties thereto, subject to review thereof by the 5 Office of General Counsel and provided the same do not increase in 6 7 the aggregate any financial obligation or liability of the City. No agreements between the City and the State of Florida Agency for Health 8 9 Care Administration will be executed and no funding disbursed by the 10 City to the State until the City confirms adequate participation in the intergovernmental transfer (IGT) program by other counties and 11 government entities in the State. 12

13 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to 14 provide for the distribution of the City's contribution to indigent 15 health care funding between Shands and the State of Florida as part 16 of the State's Medicaid Hospital Program.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
