Bill Summary: The bill

- appropriates \$100,000.00 in fund balance from the Environmental Protection Fund to assist in the Ecological Restoration of Hogans Creek to Groundwork Jacksonville, Inc., for a Preliminary Design and Feasibility Assessment, as initiated by B.T. 21-067;
- provides a carryover of funds through September 30, 2023;
- invokes the exception of Section 126.107(G)(Exemptions), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, to direct contract with Groundwork Jacksonville, Inc.;
- approves and authorizes the Mayor or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary to execute
 and deliver that certain funding agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Groundwork
 Jacksonville, Inc.;
- waives Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), *Ordinance Code*, to allow for partial advance payment by the City;
- provides for City oversight by the Neighborhoods Department, Environmental Quality Division;
 and
- requires annual reports and a final report to the Jacksonville Environmental Protection Board

Background Information: Groundwork Jacksonville, Inc (GWJ) is a non-profit organization specifically created to restore urban creeks, connect urban neighborhoods, and convert neglected and contaminated land into parks, playgrounds, trails, and other public greenspaces. Hogans Creek, a small tributary of the St. Johns River, flows south/southeast through Springfield neighborhood/downtown area before it empties into the river. The creek has been neglected over the years and in need of environmental cleanup and restoration. GWJ will provide a Preliminary Design and Feasibility Assessment to assist in the ecological restoration of Hogans Creek.

Policy Impact Area: Hogans Creek, ecological restoration, Groundwork Jacksonville

Fiscal Impact: The appropriation of \$100,000.00, as initiated by B.T. 21-067.
