Type of Action: Naming a new park

Bill Summary: This bill names a new park, donated by Allweather Tire Company to the City of Jacksonville pursuant to Section 122.412, *Ordinance Code*, and shall be called “Thebaut Sisters Landing.”

Background Information: The park is comprised of five contiguous vacant parcels totaling 2.16 acres and located on Heckscher Drive adjacent to Browns Creek in Council District 2. While two of the parcels are submerged underwater, all five parcels are classified as wasteland. Over the years, citizens have accessed the properties for fishing and launching kayaks into Browns Creek and the St. Johns River. The property owners desire to donate the properties to the City for public use, contingent the park is named “Thebaut Sisters Landing.”
