Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary to execute and deliver the Second Amendment to the License Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Lutheran Services Florida, Inc. (LSF). The amendment extends the term of the agreement for approximately 2,000 square feet of office space within the Kids Hope Alliance (KHA) building, located at 1095 A. Phillip Randolph Boulevard, Building 1, Jacksonville, FL 32206, for an additional six months, expiring on June 30, 2025. The bill requests one-cycle emergency passage due to the agreement's expiration on December 31, 2024. Oversight of the agreement will remain with the Kids Hope Alliance.

Background Information: The initial License Agreement was executed on April 13, 2021, and authorized under Ordinance 2020-760-E. It was amended on June 1, 2024, to extend the term. This Second Amendment, approved by the KHA Board on November 20, 2024, ensures continued occupancy of the space for Lutheran Services Florida, Inc., to facilitate their services provided at the KHA Building.
