5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026-2030 FIVE-YEAR
6 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
7 2025-505-E TO REVISE THE SCOPE OF THE PROJECT
8 ENTITLED "FIRE STATION 18" TO ELIMINATE PROPERTY
9 ACQUISITION AND PARKING EXPANSION AND ADD
10 EXTERIOR ELEMENTS TO IMPROVE AESTHETICS AND
11 SAFETY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance

15 2025-505-E, adopting the 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
16 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
17 hereby amended to revise the scope of the project entitled "Fire
18 Station 18" (Project Number 004312) (the "Project") to eliminate
19 property acquisition and parking expansion and add an art mural,
20 landscaping improvements and exterior lighting to enhance the
21 station's exterior appearance, integrate with the community, and
22 improve safety, as more fully described in the Project Information
23 Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this
24 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment
25 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be
26 detrimental to the best interests of the community because this
27 revised scope is applicable to current year appropriations and is
28 necessary to complete the intended work at Fire Station 18.

29 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
30 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
31 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP

1 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
2 an amendment to Ordinance 2025-505-E. In all other respects, the
3 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2025-505-E
4 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

5 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
7 without the Mayor's signature.
