8 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,000 FROM PRIVATE
9 DONATIONS TO THE JUMP START PROGRAM
10 ADMINISTERED BY NE FLORIDA SOBER LIVING
11 ALLIANCE, INC. WITHIN THE OPIOID ABUSE
12 PROGRAM TRUST FUND; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING
13 THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION
14 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, AN AGREEMENT
15 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND NE
16 FLORIDA SOBER LIVING ALLIANCE, INC.; WAIVING
17 PROVISIONS IN SECTION 118.201(F) (RELEASE OF
18 APPROPRIATIONS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, IN ORDER TO
19 ALLOW FOR ADVANCE PAYMENT OF 25% AND TO ALLOW
20 FOR THE FINAL REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED WITH THE
21 LAST PAYMENT REQUEST; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION
22 IN SECTION 126.107(G), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO
23 ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH NE FLORIDA SOBER
24 LIVING ALLIANCE, INC. TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES
25 FOR THE JUMP START PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR
26 OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT
27 COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,

1 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
2 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
3 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

4 (The account information is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, and
5 incorporated herein by this reference)

10 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is being
11 appropriated from private donations to the Jump Start
12 Program administered by NE Florida Sober Living Alliance,
13 Inc. within the Opioid Abuse Program Trust Fund to be
14 utilized for the Jump Start program.

15 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
16 Section 1 is to provide funding for the Jump Start program, as more
17 fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto. The Jump Start
18 program administered by NE Florida Sober Living Alliance, Inc.
19 will utilize this funding as a stopgap measure to provide daily
20 living assistance to individuals suffering from opioid dependence
21 or addiction with daily housing vouchers. The cost per voucher is
22 \$27 and these funds are estimated to assist 37 individuals.

23 **Section 3. Agreement approved and execution authorized.**

24 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and
25 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,
26 the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and NE
27 Florida Sober Living Alliance, Inc., in substantially the form as
28 attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 3**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit
29 3, Revised Agmt, May 3, 2021 - NCSPHS", and incorporated herein by
30 this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such
31 additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary

1 and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be
2 acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and
3 acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the
4 Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to the
5 Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of
6 the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the
7 Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of NE Florida
8 Sober Living Alliance, Inc., and any such modification shall be
9 technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and
10 approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this
11 Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes
12 having no financial impact to the City and any other non-
13 substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties
14 and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the
15 Agreement.

16 **Section 4. Waiver of the provisions in Section 118.201(f)**
17 **(Release of appropriations), Ordinance Code.** The City hereby waives
18 the provisions of Section 118.201(f) (Release of appropriations),
19 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. The waiver of Section
20 118.201(f), *Ordinance Code*, is needed in order to allow for advance
21 payment of 25% which is in excess of the of 10% allowed by Section
22 118.201, *Ordinance Code*, and to allow for the final report to be
23 submitted with the last payment request instead of November 15,
24 2021 as required by Code.

25 **Section 5. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**
26 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of
27 the professional services of NE Florida Sober Living Alliance,
28 Inc., to provide services for the Jump Start program. Pursuant to
29 Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations),
30 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is
31 exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or

1 services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within
2 authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the
3 exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126,
4 *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

5 **Section 6. Oversight.** The Mayor is requested to appoint
6 the Office of Grants and Contract Compliance to oversee the project
7 in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other
8 appropriate laws.

9 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
