AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$8,000,000.00 FROM GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO SHANDS JACKSONVILLE MEDICAL CENTER, INC. D/B/A UF HEALTH ("SHANDS") TO FUND LEGALLY REQUIRED COUNTY HOSPITAL EXPENSES, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-026; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AMENDMENT ONE TO THE INDIGENT CARE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND SHANDS DATED JUNE 2, 2005; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The appropriation above is from the General Fund Balance to Shands to fund legally required county hospital expenses.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Section 1 is to fund legally required county hospital expenses and to provide additional funding under that Amended and Restated Agreement for Indigent Care between the City and Shands dated June 2, 2005 to offset Shands expenses in providing medical care to those persons confined within the Duval County Jail or Duval County Correctional System (collectively, the "Facility"). Shands has been facing millions of dollars in extra operating expenses due to services provided to the population of the Facility. In fiscal year 2018, these costs were nearly \$10 million. In fiscal year 2019, such expenses went to \$8 million, and in fiscal year 2020, they are projected again to exceed \$8 million. These legally required services fall outside the in-house care at the Facility and create an additional expense beyond the normal operational capacity of Shands. This \$8 million budget transfer will supplement Shands' operations to ensure that there is no negative impact to the continued care provided to community members in Jacksonville. Offsetting this \$8 million transfer from the General Fund Balance is more than \$7 million in positive operational variances in the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office's budget for fiscal year 2019 which will add to General Fund Balance, as well as \$5 million in positive performance of ad valorem property tax receipts versus the amount budgeted for fiscal year 2019.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Amendment 1 to the Amended and Restated Agreement dated June 2, 2005 between the City and Shands, a copy of which is attached
