AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING WEN RAITI, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE BETTER JACKSONVILLE PLAN FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE, AS A PRIVATE CITIZEN MEMBER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 761.107, ORDINANCE CODE, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM ENDING MARCH 31, 2028; WAIVING SECTION 761.107 (COMMITTEES), CHAPTER 761 (THE BETTER JACKSONVILLE PLAN), ORDINANCE CODE, AS TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT CITIZEN MEMBERS RESIDE WITHIN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment. The Council hereby appoints Wen Raiti, a Duval County resident, to the Better Jacksonville Plan Financial Administration Committee, as a private citizen member, pursuant to Section 761.107, Ordinance Code, for a first full term ending March 31, 2028.

Section 2. Waiver of Section 761.107, Ordinance Code.

Section 761.107 (Committees), Chapter 761 (The Better Jacksonville Plan), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived as to the requirement that citizen members of the Better Jacksonville Plan Financial Administration Committee reside within the City of Jacksonville. Although the appointee does not reside within City limits, Ms. Raiti has a substantial economic business interest in the City of Jacksonville, as she is the founder and operator of the House of Leaf & Bean located in Springfield at 1349 N. Market Street, Jacksonville,
