9 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND LOAN PROCEEDS TO PROVIDE
10 FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, CONTINGENCY, AND
11 PERSONNEL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPAIR AND
12 UPGRADE OF BRIDGE 724085 ON ORCHARD STREET, AS
13 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-092; AMENDING THE 2020-
14 2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
15 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE
16 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED ""; PROVIDING
17 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
22 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
23 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

1 The funding above is from interest earnings

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to provide funding to upgrade to current Florida
4 Department of Transportation (FDOT) standards the guardrails on
5 Bridge 724085 on Orchard Street and thus provide the driving public
6 with traffic railing that will better prevent errant vehicles from
7 breaking through the railing and crashing into the creek. The
8 asphalt at the approaches to the bridge is damaged and needs to be
9 repaired. The repair items associated with this project constitute
10 safety upgrades and major maintenance to the bridge guardrail and
11 pedestrian barriers.

12 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being
13 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City
14 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to
15 reduce funding for the project entitled "Countywide Intersection
16 IMP, Brge-Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled
17 "Orchard Street Bridge Upgrades." The projects are more fully
18 described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as
19 **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP,
20 August 3, 2020 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference.
21 The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP
22 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to
23 the best interests of the community because such deferral will
24 result in unnecessary delay in repairing critical transportation
25 infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,
26 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-
27 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the
28 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall
29 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other
30 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by
31 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

1 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
2 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
3 without the Mayor's signature.
