Section 3. Reverter. Any remaining funds after the completion of the Project shall be returned to the account of origin.

Section 4. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage upon introduction of this ordinance is requested due to the depletion of most of JFRD's fire suppression foam in assisting with the Brunswick, Georgia fire on April 15, 2023. JFRD needs to move expeditiously to replenish its supply of fire suppression foam to assist with any local industrial fires that may occur.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
