ORDINANCE 2023-798

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,075,000.00 CONSISTING \$1,000,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE U.S. OF DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION ("SAMHSA"), AND A KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE ("KHA") MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000 FROM THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE GRANT FUND, FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CO-DESIGNING ENVIRONMENTS FOR ALL TO THRIVE EVERYDAY ("CREATE") PROGRAM, FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE FOUR (4) YEAR GRANT TERM BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 29, 2027, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-019; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; APPROVING A POSITION, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 24-011; AMENDING REVISED SCHEDULE M TO ORDINANCE 2023-511-E; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, WITH RESPECT TO SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC.; APPROVING, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CONTRACT WITH MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE CREATE PROGRAM; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111(A) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC.

1 FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING FOR 2 OVERSIGHT BY KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE; PROVIDING AN 3 EFFECTIVE DATE. 4 5 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 6 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, 7 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 8 9 listed in subsection (b): 10 (B.T. 24-019, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 11 by this reference) (a) Appropriated from: 12 See B.T. 24-019 \$1,075,000.00 13 Appropriated to: 14 (b) See B.T. 24-019 15 \$1,075,000.00 Explanation of Appropriation: 16 (C) The 17 funding above represents an appropriation \$1,000,000.00 in SAMHSA grant funds for implementation of 18 the Co-Designing Rich Environments For All To Thrive 19 20 Everyday ("CREATE") Program, with an additional 21 appropriation of \$75,000.00 from Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") 22 representing a local match for the first year of the grant. 23 The overall grant term is four (4) years, with the first 24 year beginning September 30, 2023 and ending September 29, 2024. 25 Purpose. 26 Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in 27 Section 1 is to provide funding for the first year of the CREATE 2.8 Program for the period beginning September 30, 2023 through September 29 29, 2024, and to procure the professional services of Managed Access to Child Health, Inc., to implement and carry out the CREATE Program. 30 31 The CREATE Program is designed to provide mental health services for

children with serious emotional disturbances targeting children and youth with special health care needs, youth transitioning from pediatric to adult care, and LGBTQ+ children and youth.

Section 3. Approval of Position. There is hereby approved the position more fully described in R.C. 24-011, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. Said position is fully funded by SAMHSA grant dollars and will provide services in support of the SAMHSA program.

Section 4. Amending Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 2023-511-E. There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2023-2024 budget for KHA by substituting in the place of the Revised Schedule M, approved by Ordinance 2023-511-E, the Second Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Second Revised Schedule M reflects the funds appropriated herein.

Section 5. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. KHA is hereby authorized to procure professional services from Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. for local implementation and administration of the CREATE Program in compliance with the grant described in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to this Ordinance.

Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. pursuant to which Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. will provide professional services necessary for local implementation and

administration of the CREATE Program in compliance with the grant described in Section 2.

Section 7. Waiver of the Requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code, with respect to the contract with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. approved and authorized in Section 6 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services provided by third parties to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed in order to allow KHA to directly contract with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. to provide the CREATE Program services described in the grant described in Section 2.

Section 8. Oversight Department. The Kids Hope Alliance shall oversee administration of the grant and the CREATE Program.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
