Amending Section 30.201 16 (Establishment; membership), Part 2 (Planning Commission), Chapter 30 (Planning and 17 30.201 18 Section Development Department), Ordinance Code. (Establishment; membership), Part 2 (Planning Commission), Chapter 19 20 30 (Planning and Development Department), Ordinance Code, is hereby 21 amended to read as follows: 22 CHAPTER 30 - PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT 23 PART 2. - PLANNING COMMISSION 24 25 Sec. 30.201. - Establishment; membership. There is established within the Department, 26 (a) as an autonomous component thereof, a Planning Commission 27 (hereafter referred to as "Commission") consisting of nine 2.8 29 members, and three alternates, appointed by the Mayor and 30 confirmed by the Council for a term of three years. Of the nine members and three alternates, one member shall be 31

appointed from and shall be continuously throughout his term a resident of each City Planning District, and three members and the three alternates shall be appointed atlarge and shall be residents of the City during their entire terms; provided, however, that the member from the Urban Core Planning District shall be a resident of, or own a business in, that District; failure to retain these qualifications shall automatically remove the person not qualified from serving as a member or alternate. The three alternates shall either be former Planning Commission members or former City Council members who have served on the Land Use and Zoning Committee of the City Council. Members and alternates shall be appointed for three-year staggered terms (except appointments to fill vacancies). The membership of the Commission shall include, to the extent available, three persons who are educated or practice in one of the disciplines of planning, design, development or related disciplines. No member shall serve for more than two consecutive full terms; but appointments fill vacancies for unexpired terms and initial to appointments under the preceding sentence for less than three years shall not be deemed to be full terms. A member or alternate may be removed by the Mayor during his term, with the approval of the Council. A vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment, for the unexpired term. Members shall serve without compensation, but shall be entitled to travel expense reimbursement in accordance with Part 7, Chapter 106. The provisions of F.S. \$ 286.012, as amended from time to time, shall apply to each member and alternate of the Commission.

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Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the 1 Section 2. 2 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and 3 division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any other changes necessary to 4 make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation 5 are approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code 6 7 shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered. Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 8 9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 10 without the Mayor's signature. 11
