**Bill Summary:** This bill appropriates \$200,000 from the Council President's Designated Contingency to fund the Public Service Grant ("PSG") Micro-Grant Program Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs Category for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. It provides for carryover of funds to Fiscal Year 2024-2025.

**Background Information:** The Public Service Grant Council met on February 12, 2024, to approve the fiscal year 2024-25 categories of Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs. Per their recommendations, \$200,000 from the total funding was to be allocated to the PSG Council for fiscal year 2024-2025. The Council approved these categories via Ordinance 2024-198-E; however, the final bill stated that the Micro-Grant Pilot Program would not be funded through the annual appropriation to PSG Council but would instead be funded through a separate appropriation. This bill represents the separate appropriation to provide this funding for the Micro-Grant Pilot Program for FY 2024-2025.
