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## ORDINANCE 2025-64

5 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE TIMELINE FOR WRECKER FIRMS TO COMPLY WITH A NOTICE OF LIEN; AMENDING 6 7 CHAPTER 804 (JACKSONVILLE TRAFFIC CODE), PART 12 (WRECKER FACILITIES AND CHARGES), SECTION 8 9 804.1204 (TOWING, OTHER SERVICES AND STORAGE CHARGES; NOTICE BY THE SHERIFF) TO REDUCE THE 10 11 TIME FOR A WRECKER TO SEND THE NOTICE OF LIEN REGARDING AN IMPOUNDED VEHICLE OR VESSEL AND TO 12 13 REDUCE THE DELAY IN CHARGING TOWING 14 ADMINISTRATIVE FEES; AMENDING CHAPTER 804 15 (JACKSONVILLE TRAFFIC CODE), PART 13 (TOWING ON 16 PRIVATE PROPERTY), SECTION 804.1306 17 (ESTABLISHMENT OF RATES) TO REDUCE THE TIME FOR 18 A WRECKER TO SEND THE NOTICE OF LIEN REGARDING 19 AN IMPOUNDED VEHICLE OR VESSEL AND TO REDUCE THE DELAY IN CHARGING TOWING ADMINISTRATIVE FEES; 20 21 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. Section 804.1204 (Towing, other services and
storage charges; notice by the Sheriff) amended. Chapter 804
(Jacksonville Traffic Code), Part 12 (Wrecker Facilities and Charges)
Section 804.1204 (Towing, other services and storage charges; notice
by the Sheriff.), Ordinance Code, is amended to read as follows:

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CHAPTER 804 JACKSONVILLE TRAFFIC CODE

PART 12. WRECKER FACILITIES AND CHARGES

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Sec. 804.1204. - Towing, other services and storage charges; notice by the Sheriff.

3 When a motor vehicle must be transported to a public storage lot 4 or to a location within the designated towing zone, standard charges for towing and storage or other services shall be charged by wrecker 5 and towing firms and by the City to owners of motor vehicles directed 6 7 to be towed by the Sheriff's Office. Whenever a motor vehicle is directed to be towed by the Sheriff's Office, the towing firm shall 8 9 within seven five business days from the date of such direction notify in writing the registered owner of the motor vehicle and any and all 10 lienholders of record (as appears on the motor vehicle registration 11 12 or as disclosed by the records in the State Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles). The notice shall contain the date and 13 14 time of towing, the name of the registered owner of the motor vehicle, 15 the name of the towing company and the address at which the towed 16 motor vehicle is stored. In the event the towed motor vehicle has a 17 temporary license tag affixed to it, the towing firm shall, if possible, provide the same notice required herein within seven five 18 business days to the entity to which the temporary license tag was 19 20 issued. At the request of an owner or driver for his vehicle to be 21 towed to another location, charges shall be negotiated between the 22 owner or driver and the towing firm. Charges for towing and storage 23 or other services and the classification of wrecker service shall be 24 determined by the vehicle to be towed or service to be performed, and 25 shall not exceed the charges set forth in www.jaxsheriff.org/fees for 26 the following schedules:

TOWING AND OTHER SERVICE CHARGES

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29 (q) Administrative Fees:

(1) A towing firm may, after the first <del>72</del> <u>48</u> hours, charge an administrative fee not to exceed an amount for actual

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documented costs associated with notice advertising and with research for and mailing of certified notices to registered owners and lien holders of record as required by F.S. § 713.78(3), but the actual documented cost shall not exceed a rate found in www.jaxsheriff.org/fees.

Section 2. Section 804.1306 (Establishment of Rates) amended. Chapter 804 (Jacksonville Traffic Code), Part 13 (Towing on Private Property) Section 804.1306 (Establishment of rates), Ordinance Code, is amended to read as follows:

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PART 13. TOWING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

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Sec. 804.1306. - Establishment of rates

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15 (c) The maximum rates established in paragraph (1) above shall 16 be a flat fee which shall be all inclusive and, by way of illustration, 17 no additional charges shall be made for: (1) Any fees for special 18 equipment or services such as double hook up, vehicle entry when 19 locked, dropping transmission linkage, axle or drive shaft removal, 20 dollies, trailer or flat bed, lifts, slim jims, go jacks, removing 21 bumpers, airing up brakes, and mileage; (2) Time spent at the scene of 22 the tow; or (3) Storage for the first six hours.

23 No other fees of whatever kind may be charged for services rendered 24 during the first 72 48 hours that the vehicle is in the possession 25 of the towing service, beginning from the time the vehicle is 26 delivered to the storage facility. Storage fees as set forth above 27 may be assessed after the initial six-hour period based on a 24-hour 28 day, each day starting at the time of impound. An administrative fee 29 not to exceed for actual documented costs may be charged after the 30 first 72 48 hours so long as the towing service has actually complied 31 with the requirements of F.S. § 713.78 for actual documented costs,

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1	including execution and mailing of the lien notice, but shall not
2	exceed the rate found in www.jaxsheriff.org/fees.
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4	Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
5	effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6	without the Mayor's signature.
