7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,000,000,
8 INCLUDING A \$2,500,000 GRANT AWARDED BY THE
9 STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF STATE FIRE MARSHAL
10 WITH A \$2,500,000 LOCAL MATCH FROM THE CITY OF
11 JACKSONVILLE FOR THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND
12 RESCUE DEPARTMENT HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER
13 (THE "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T.
14 22-104; AMENDING THE 2022-2026 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL
15 IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2021-505-
16 E TO REFLECT THE STATE CONTRIBUTION AND LOCAL
17 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT
18 BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT;
19 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
23 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
24 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
25 listed in subsection (b):

26 (Revised B.T. 22-104, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled
27 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev B.T. 22-104, September 19, 2022 - NCSPHS"
28 and incorporated herein by this reference)

2 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

3 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
4 funding in the amount of \$2,500,000 from the Division of
5 State Fire Marshal with a \$2,500,000 local match for the
6 Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department ("JFRD") Health
7 and Wellness Center.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to provide funding to procure and outfit a new location
10 for the JFRD Health and Wellness Center which provides a central
11 facility for a number of major health services including medical
12 fitness, injury/rehabilitation, and mental health (the "Project").
13 The ability to provide these services from the current location is
14 limited by physical constraints of the building from which the
15 services are performed and offered. These funds will be used to
16 renovate, outfit and furnish a new location for the Health and
17 Wellness Center, including a significant investment to outfit the
18 facility to provide radiology services. A copy of the Division of
19 State Fire Marshal award letter and House Bill 3401 reflecting the
20 award of funding from the State are attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

21 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
22 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
23 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
24 hereby amended to add the Health and Wellness Center Project to the
25 CIP and to reflect this funding for the Project as more fully
26 described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as **Revised**
27 **Exhibit 3**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev CIP Sheet, September
28 19, 2022 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The
29 City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP
30 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to
31 the best interests of the community because such deferral will

1 unnecessarily delay the ability to provide a comprehensive
2 occupational Firefighter Health and Wellness Center.

3 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
4 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
5 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
6 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
7 an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the
8 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E
9 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

10 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
11 Department shall oversee administration of the grant and the Project
12 described herein.

13 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
15 without the Mayor's signature.
