6 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NEW SECTION 111.275
7 (JACKSONVILLE VETERANS AND MILITARY FAMILY
8 COMMUNITY CENTER AND FACILITIES TRUST FUND),
9 PART 2 (HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES), CHAPTER 111
10 (SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE*
11 *CODE*, TO ESTABLISH A JACKSONVILLE VETERANS AND
12 MILITARY FAMILY COMMUNITY CENTER AND FACILITIES
13 TRUST FUND FOR THE PURPOSES DESCRIBED HEREIN;
14 PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS;
15 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Creating a new Section 111.275 (Jacksonville**
19 **Veterans and Military Family Community Center and Facilities Trust**
20 **Fund), Part 2 (Health and Human Services), Chapter 111 (Special**
21 **Revenue and Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*.** A new Section 111.275
22 (Jacksonville Veterans and Military Family Community Center and
23 Facilities Trust Fund), Part 2 (Health and Human Services), Chapter
24 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby
25 created to read as follows:

26 **CHAPTER 111. SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS**

28 **PART 2. HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES**

30 **Sec. 111.275. - Jacksonville Veterans and Military Family Community**
31 **Center and Facilities Trust Fund.**

1 There is hereby created the Jacksonville Veterans and Military
2 Family Community Center and Facilities Trust Fund (the "Fund"), a
3 permanent trust fund of the City, into which shall be deposited all
4 donations, gifts, grants, fees, transfers and funds as may be from
5 time to time received by the City for the purpose of designing,
6 planning, constructing, maintaining, operating, staffing and
7 equipping a Jacksonville Veterans and Military Family Community
8 Center and other similar veterans facilities. The sums placed into
9 the Fund, together with any interest accrued thereon, are hereby
10 appropriated for purposes described in this Section, and such
11 appropriations shall not lapse at the close of any fiscal year but
12 shall carry over to the next fiscal year. The Director of the Finance
13 Department is authorized and directed to make disbursements from the
14 Fund upon the written request of the Director of the Military Affairs
15 and Veterans Department, subject to availability of funds from the
16 Fund, however, any single expenditure from this Fund in excess of
17 \$100,000 shall require prior Council approval. No later than June 30
18 annually, the Director of the Military Affairs and Veterans Department
19 shall provide a report of receipts and disbursements to the City
20 Council.

21 **Section 2. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the
22 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and
23 division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth
24 herein, including renumbering of sections. Such editorial changes and
25 any other changes necessary to make the *Ordinance Code* consistent
26 with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein,
27 and the changes to the *Ordinance Code* shall be made forthwith and
28 when inconsistencies are discovered.

29 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
31 without the Mayor's signature.
