Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Meredith Chartrand Frisch, as a member of the Kids Hope Alliance Board, replacing Rebekah Davis, for a partial term to expire on December 31, 2023, followed by a first full term to expire on December 31, 2027.

Background Information: The Kids Hope Alliance is established pursuant to Chapter 77, *Ordinance Code* to offer a comprehensive and integrated system of essential children and youth programs and services to address the critical needs of children and youth. KHA is responsible for comprehensively developing, overseeing, managing and implementing the Essential Services Plan for Kids, and managing the children and youth programs, services, and activities permitted under the Plan through third-party service providers and other City agencies.

Section 77.106, *Ordinance Code*, provides that Kids Hope Alliance Board be comprised of seven voting members who are permanent residents of the City, appointed by the Mayor, and confirmed by the Council.

Ms. Frisch holds a bachelor's degree from Florida State University, and she previously worked as the grants manager for the Chartrand Foundation. Ms. Frisch is a member of the Chartrand Foundation Board, the Women's Giving Alliance, and the KIPP Jacksonville Board. She resides in Duval County in council district 13.
