5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,696,404.03 IN  
6 AVAILABLE FUNDS FROM TWO DRAINAGE SYSTEM  
7 REHABILITATION PROJECTS TO: (1) THE WOOLERY  
8 DRIVE DRAINAGE STUDY AND IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT;  
9 (2) THE EMERALD TRAIL - S-LINE TO STONEWALL  
10 STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; (3) THE HARLOW  
11 BOULEVARD/MOTHER HUBBARD DRIVE SOUTH (DSR) -  
12 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; (4) THE INGLESIDE  
13 AVENUE (DSR) - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; (5)  
14 THE IRVING SCOTT DRIVE (DSR) - CAPITAL  
15 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND (6) THE ORTEGA  
16 BOULEVARD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AS  
17 INITIATED BY B.T. 23-110; PURPOSE OF  
18 APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR  
19 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY  
20 ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL  
21 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECTS ENTITLED "WOOLERY DRIVE  
22 DRAINAGE STUDY AND IMPROVEMENTS," "EMERALD TRAIL  
23 - S-LINE TO STONEWALL STREET IMPROVEMENTS,"  
24 "HARLOW BOULEVARD/MOTHER HUBBARD DRIVE SOUTH  
25 (DSR) - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT," "INGLESIDE AVENUE  
26 (DSR) - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT," "IRVING SCOTT  
27 DRIVE (DSR) - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT," AND "ORTEGA  
28 BOULEVARD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS;" PROVIDING AN  
29 EFFECTIVE DATE.

31 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

1           **Section 1.           Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
2 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
3 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
4 listed in subsection (b):

11           (c) Explanation of Appropriation

12                   The funding above is a transfer of \$1,696,404.03 from two  
13 drainage system rehabilitation projects to six named  
14 projects to supplement previously appropriated funds,  
15 thereby allowing for the completion of the six drainage  
16 improvement projects. The appropriation will not cause the  
17 City to incur additional debt.

18           **Section 2.           Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
19 Section 1 is to provide additional funding for the following six (6)  
20 drainage improvement projects: (i) Woolery Drive Drainage Study and  
21 Improvements project; (ii) Emerald Trail - S-Line to Stonewall Street  
22 Improvements project; (iii) Harlow Boulevard/Mother Hubbard Drive  
23 South (DSR) - Capital Improvement project; (iv) Ingleside Avenue  
24 (DSR) - Capital Improvement project; (v) Irving Scott Drive (DSR) -  
25 Capital Improvement project; and, (vi) Ortega Boulevard Drainage  
26 Improvements project.

27           **Section 3.           CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2022-505-E, being the  
28 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and  
29 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide  
30 additional funding for the projects entitled: "Woolery Drive Drainage  
31 Study and Improvements;" "Emerald Trail - S-Line to Stonewall Street

1 Improvements;" "Harlow Boulevard/Mother Hubbard Drive South (DSR) -  
2 Capital Improvement," "Ingleside Avenue (DSR) - Capital Improvement"  
3 "Irving Scott Drive (DSR) - Capital Improvement" and "Ortega Boulevard  
4 Drainage Improvements." The projects are more fully described in the  
5 Project Information Sheets attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and  
6 incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the  
7 deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget  
8 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the  
9 community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delays in  
10 the completion of the drainage projects.

11 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of  
12 this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
13 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment  
14 set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an  
15 amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-  
16 Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E  
17 shall continue in full force and effect.

18 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
20 without the Mayor's signature.
