ORDINANCE 2025-377-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$326,162.22 FROM THE COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP, BRGE - BRIDGES PROJECT TO THE ART MUSEUM DRIVE BRIDGE PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") TO PAY FOR COSTS RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRS RELATED TO THE ART MUSEUM DRIVE BRIDGE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-082; AMENDING THE 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

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(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$326,162.22 from the Countywide Intersection Imp, Brge - Bridges project to the Art Museum Drive Bridge project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Countywide Intersection Imp, Brge - Bridges project to the Art Museum Drive Bridge project (the "Project"). The Project will upgrade the guardrail to current FDOT standards, raise the approach slabs to original design profile, and repair the damaged sidewalks in the vicinity of the bridge.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheets, June 16, 2025 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay the commencement and completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. The Department of Public Works, Engineering and Construction Management Division shall have oversight with respect

to the project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
