COMMISSION, FILLING A SEAT FORMERLY HELD BY
MAXIMILIAN S. GLOBER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 76.102
(MEMBERSHIP), CHAPTER 76 (JACKSONVILLE HISTORIC
PRESERVATION COMMISSION), *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A
FIRST FULL TERM EXPIRING ON MARCH 4, 2029;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment. The Council hereby confirms the
Mayor's appointment of C. Douglas Lane, a Duval County resident, to
the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission, filling a seat
formerly held by Maximilian S. Globler, pursuant to Section 76.102
(Membership), Chapter 76 (Jacksonville Historic Preservation
Commission), *Ordinance Code*, for a first full term expiring on March
4, 2029.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become
effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
without the Mayor's signature.
