16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2026-2027 fiscal year,

27 The funding above represents an appropriation from
28 Permanent and Probationary Salaries to Salaries Part-Time for the
29 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant program from the United
30 States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance ("Grant
31 Program"). No local match is required. The Grant period is from

October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2027.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to utilize the Grant Program funding to provide for a part-time data specialist in support of the Grant Program.

Section 3. Approval of Part-Time Hours. There is hereby approved two thousand part-time hours more fully described in R.C. 27-005, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and incorporated herein by this reference. The part-time hours will be utilized for data entry and analysis in support of the Grant Program.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
