ΑN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 10.19± ACRES, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6, AT THE END OF COLEMAN ROAD, OFF OF HOOD ROAD, AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY CATHIE HOLBROOK DAVIS, ET AL., FROM RESIDENTIAL RURAL-ACRE (RR-ACRE) DISTRICT TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, TO PERMIT SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL USES, AS DESCRIBED IN THE COLEMAN ROAD PUD; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Cathie Holbrook Davis, et al., the owners of approximately 10.19± acres, located in Council District 6, at the end of Coleman Road, off of Hood Road, as more particularly described in Exhibit 1, dated December 26, 2019, and graphically depicted in Exhibit 2, both of which are attached hereto (Subject Property), have applied for a rezoning and reclassification of that property from Residential Rural-Acre (RR-Acre) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District, as described in Section 1 below; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the application and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice and public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that such rezoning is: (1) consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; (2) furthers the goals, objectives and policies of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and (3) is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds the proposed rezoning does not adversely affect the orderly development of the City as embodied in the Zoning Code; will not adversely affect the health and safety of residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties in the general neighborhood; and will accomplish the objectives and meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit Development) of the Zoning Code; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Residential Rural-Acre (RR-Acre) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District. This new PUD district shall generally permit single family residential uses, and is described, shown and subject to the following documents, attached hereto:

- Exhibit 1 Legal Description dated December 26, 2019.
- Exhibit 2 Subject Property per P&DD.
- Revised Exhibit 3 Revised Written Description dated January 9, 2020.
- Revised Exhibit 4 Revised Site Plan dated June 9, 2020.
- Section 2. Owner and Description. The Subject Property is owned by Cathie Holbrook Davis, et al., and is legally described in Exhibit 1, attached hereto. The agent is Curtis L. Hart, 8051 Tara Lane, Jacksonville, Florida 32216; (904) 993-5008.
- Section 3. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein shall not be construed as an exemption from any other applicable
