Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the Interlocal Agreement between the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the City of Jacksonville. The Office of Administrative Services, Environmental Quality Division will provide oversight. Agreement term commences on June 1, 2026, and expires on May 31, 2031.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to authorize the agreement for the allocation and implementation of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program requirements. FDOT holds an NPDES Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Phase 1 Permit, which includes a monitoring plan (MS4 permit). The Agreement will allow FDOT to support the work of the City, including funding certain costs, associated with water quality sampling, Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination (IDDE), High Risk Facility Inspection (HRF) and reporting requirements associated with the MS4 permit.
