AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$455,000.00 FROM THE UNDERDRAIN REPLACEMENTS PROJECT TO THE BROOKSHIRE COURT UNDERDRAIN REHABILITATION PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") TO PAY FOR THE REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF APPROXIMATELY 835 FEET OF EXISTING UNDERDRAIN ON BROOKSHIRE COURT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-145; AMENDING THE 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO REFLECT APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

- (B.T. 24-145, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference)
 - (a) Appropriated from:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$455,000.00 from the Underdrain Replacements Project to the Brookshire Court Underdrain Rehabilitation Project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Underdrain Replacements Project to the Brookshire Court Underdrain Rehabilitation Project (the "Project") for the construction and installation of the Project. The Project will entail removal and replacement of approximately 835 feet of existing underdrain on Brookshire Court and tie into the existing inlet drainage system. The Project will reduce driveway flooding along Brookshire Court and improve drainage at surrounding ponds.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheets, September 30, 2024 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay the commencement and completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E
