5 AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$40,000 FROM THE ART  
6 IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT FUND TO THE SOUTHSIDE  
7 SENIOR CENTER ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT TO  
8 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR INSTALLATION OF PUBLIC ART,  
9 AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-033; PURPOSE OF  
10 APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2022-2026 FIVE-YEAR  
11 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE  
12 2021-505-E TO REFLECT THIS TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO  
13 THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
17 within the City’s budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
18 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
19 listed in subsection (b):

26 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:  
27 The funding above represents a transfer of \$40,000 from  
28 the Art in Public Places Project fund to the Southside  
29 Senior Center Art in Public Places project (the “Project”)  
30 to provide funding for installation of public art.

31 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in

1 Section 1 is to transfer funds to the Southside Senior Center Art in  
2 Public Places project to pay the costs for installation of a three-  
3 dimensional public art piece at this location.

4 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance  
5 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan  
6 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is  
7 hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the  
8 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets  
9 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this  
10 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment  
11 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be  
12 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such  
13 deferral will unnecessarily delay the opportunity to bring public art  
14 to this part of the community.

15 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of  
16 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
17 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP  
18 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute  
19 an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the  
20 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E  
21 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

22 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
24 without the Mayor's signature.
